

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To The Governing Body Nav Bharat Jagriti Kendra

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying Financial Statements of Nav Bharat Jagriti Kendra, at Village Bahera, P.O:- Brindavan, Chouparan, Hazaribagh-825406, Jharkhand which comprise the Balance Sheet as at 31st March 2024, Income & Expenditure Account, Receipt & Payment Account for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies.

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the aforesaid Financial Statements give a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India:

- a) In case of the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the society as at 31st March 2024;
- b) In case of the Income and Expenditure Account for the year ended on that date.
- c) In case of the Receipt & Payment Account for the year ended on that date.

Basis for Opinion

SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND NOTES FORMING PART OF ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED ON 31st MARCH 2024

SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES A.

The accounts are prepared on historical cost basis as a 'going concern'. 1. Incomes are accounted as and when received and expenses are accounted as and when incurred. The same is in line with the generally accepted accounting principles and practices and Accounting Standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India for NGOs, wherever applicable, except otherwise stated. For Income Tax purposes, application of income is determined on payment basis.

Fixed Assets 2.

- Fixed Assets are stated at their written-down value, net of depreciation charged for the year. Depreciation on fixed assets is charged as per the rates prescribed under the Income Tax Act on the written down value of the assets.
- Assets procured out of project funds are charged as expenses. To ensure true and fair presentation of the financials, the same have also been reported as Fixed Asset with the corresponding value in Fixed Asset Fund. Depreciation on these assets is charged to the fixed asset fund created.
- Investments in Fixed Deposits are held in the name of the organization and 3. are reported at their carrying value, which includes accrued interest.

NOTES TO ACCOUNTS B.

- The organization is registered under FCRA. The provisions of FCRA require 1. separate books of accounts to be maintained for all foreign receipts and utilization. The trust has maintained separate books of account for Foreign Contribution and Local Contribution in the Tally Prime ERP software used for the accounting.
- The Provisions of the Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 are applicable to the 1. organization and as such, a staff welfare/ gratuity fund has been created to meet the gratuity settlements of employees, as and when they occur.

Fines and penalties on account of non-compliances with certain procedures 3. are accounted for as and when levied/settled. Carlow Monpy
