Union Tribal Affairs Minister Inaugurates Liquor Prohibition Conference

Kharsawan (Saraikela), 02 April 2023: Union Tribal Affairs Minister Mr. Arjun Munda and National President of Lok Samiti Mr. Girija Satish jointly inaugurated a one-day prohibition conference organized by Yuva Jagriti Evang Swavalamban Sangh in collaboration with NBJK and Jamnalal Bajaj Foundation.

Hon. Minister emphasized the need to avoid consumption of not only alcohol but also other dangerous drugs. Mr. Girija called for a political willpower, financial discipline, phased action and cooperation from all

sections of society to make prohibition possible.

The event was attended by several social workers and hundreds of people, including women leaders, who submitted a memorandum to the Union Tribal Affairs Minister regarding the demand for liquor ban.

Electric Motor Pumps to Farmer Groups

Jamui-Deoghar, 09-10 April 2023: NBJK, with the support of SBI Foundation, has successfully provided electric motor pumps of 2 hp / 1.5 hp to 100 farmers groups from 20 villages of Deoghar Sadar and



Chakai blocks of Deoghar and Jamui districts of Jharkhand-Bihar.

The initiative took place under Gram Saksham project which aims to empower villages with sustainable solutions. The govt. officials, PRIs members and local dignitaries have graced the events.

The distribution of these electric motor pumps has greatly benefited the farmers in the area, as they can now irrigate their fields easily and more efficiently. This will help increase agricultural productivity and improve the livelihoods of the farmers.

each of the 152 local farmer families living in Chhota Baru, Gajgaon, Siankel, and Otongora villages in Murhu and Khunti block of Khunti district. The farmers were trained on the management of poultry units, especially on chicks' health care and disease prevention.
