DVC and LNJP Eye Hospital Conduct Successful Eye Camp in Koderma District

(Chouparan, Hazaribagh) organized a transformative Eye Screening Camp at DVC Club in Kanti Panchayat of Chandwara block under Koderma district. The inauguration, graced by Mr. Dilip Kumar Singh (Chief Engineer, DVC), Mr. Harishchandra Singh (DGM-CSR, DVC), and local leaders, marked a significant milestone.

The camp provided free eye checkups to 475 villagers, distributing essential care to 280 individuals with medications, 276 with spectacles, and identifying 95 cases of Cataract. Swift actions were taken, transporting Cataract patients for necessary surgeries at the base hospital.
