Mission Rozgar Job Fair Empowers Youth with Employment Opportunities

Hazaribagh, 23 December 2024: The Mission Rozgar project, a joint initiative by NBJK and SBI Life, organized a Job Fair at Prince Hotel, Hazaribagh, connecting skilled trainees from its 2nd and 3rd batches with reputed employers.

The event resulted in 40 trainees receiving on-the-spot appointments with salaries ranging from ₹3,500 to ₹9,000, while 10-15 trainees were shortlisted for final selection. Employers like Reliance Trend, ICICI Lombard, Chola Finance, Hexire Group, Apna Mart and others participated.



NBJK-SBI Life also awarded certificates to 228 youth on 18 December, recognizing their

training in trades like Computer Applications, Nursing, Beautician Services, and Tailoring. Senior Program Manager Rajeev Singh highlighted that NBJK has trained over 50,000 youth in 17 years, with 60% securing livelihoods. Training Center In-charge Rupesh Mallick reported 154 trainees already employed or self-employed, showcasing the program's impact.

Adolescent Girls' Health Camps & Swachh Bharat Campaign Held across Chatra, Godda and Pakur

Chatra-Godda-Pakur, 22 December 2024: NBJK, under the SBI Foundation-supported SBI Sanjeevani Clinic on Wheels initiative, organized adolescent health camps and cleanliness drives in remote villages of Chatra, Godda, and Pakur districts, Jharkhand. In Nawada village of Kunda block, Chatra, awareness sessions on health and hygiene during adolescence were held, and 70 sanitary napkins and 100 soaps were distributed. A cleanliness drive involving villagers included spraying bleaching powder to ensure hygiene.

In Dhobai village, Paraiyhat block, Godda, 142 participants attended a menstrual hygiene session, and 13 garbage bins were installed to promote waste management.

Similarly, in Badasinghpur village, Pakuria block, Pakur, 140 participants joined health sessions. Bleaching powder was sprayed, and 13 garbage bins were placed to maintain cleanliness.

The camps also provided free health checkups and medicines, emphasizing clean surroundings for a healthier tomorrow.



SBI Gram Saksham: Empowering Farmers with Sustainable Solutions

Chakai-Deoghar, 17 December 2024: Under the Gram Saksham Project by NBJK and SBI Foundation, farmers in Chakai block (Jamui, Bihar) and Deoghar Sadar block (Deoghar, Jharkhand) are reaping benefits of enhanced irrigation and sustainable farming practices.

On 16 December, 44 electric motor pumps were distributed to Farmer Groups in Chakai in the presence of SBI Manager Mr. Vidyut Shekhar. Earlier this month, 72 Farmer Groups received pumps from BAO Mr. Shivshankar Singh. Similarly, on 12 December, 22 motor pumps were distributed in Basakola village, with Mukhiya Mr. Umesh Yadav lauding the

initiative. In Gokhudih, 49 Farmer Groups received pumps from SBI PO Mr. Sahjanand Kumar, who also promoted Sukanya Samriddhi Yojna.

Additionally, the project has renovated 100 wells and 23 ponds, while providing training on sustainable farming. SBI Gram Saksham is fostering growth and resilience in rural farming communities.

The daily menu

consists of sprouted gram/moong with milk for breakfast and rice, pulses, and vegetables for lunch, making sure the students receive the essential nutrients needed for growth and learning. This initiative lightens the financial burden on parents and helps foster a greater sense of equality and inclusivity among students. It ensures that every child, no matter their background, gets the same nourishing meal, which directly supports their academic performance. Together, we are helping to build healthier, happier learners and creating a brighter future for these young minds!
