

Empowering Teachers, Uplifting Girls' Education!

Hazaribagh, January 18, 2025: NBJK, with support from Action Village India, organized a one-day Orientation & Training Program for teachers of remedial coaching centers under the Girls' Education Project.

■These centers, operating across 13 villages in Sadar, Katkamsandi, and Katkamdag blocks, provide specialized tuition in Mathematics, Science, and English to help schoolgirls in classes 8, 9, and 10 excel.

▼ During the session, teachers shared strategies
for preparing girls for board exams, ensuring even

academically weaker students succeed. Mr. Rajeev Singh, Senior Program Manager, emphasized the need for extra efforts with exams fast approaching.

Regional Supervisor, Mr. Abhay Kumar, highlighted recent teacher-parent meetings that addressed academic challenges and promoted equal opportunities for girls. Parents were urged to encourage education and stand against child marriage.

What's happening?

- Vermi-compost Unit: Produced 825 MT of compost from cow dung, benefiting local farmers, nurseries, agriculture enterprises & the forest department.
- Green Millboard Unit: Manufactured 370 MT of millboard from scrap paper, supporting bookbinders, box makers, notebook printers & photo framers across Jharkhand.
- Impact: Employment for 16 locals (women & men), enhancing skills & creating self-sustainability.

Empowering Communities through Skill Development and Livelihood Support

Hazaribagh, January 15, 2025: At NBJK, we are transforming lives across Jharkhand and Bihar with impactful initiatives:

Skill Training for Youth

575 young individuals trained in trades like Basic Computer Applications, General Duty Assistant, Beautician-Mehendi, Tailoring-Embroidery, and Tally. Of these, 321 have secured jobs or started self-employment.

☑ Tailoring Training for Women

216 rural women equipped with stitching and designing skills, and 116 supported to set up

their own tailoring schools with sewing machines and essential resources.

✓ Micro-Enterprise Support

155 individuals, including 100 women, started micro-enterprises with financial assistance, creating 217 jobs in rural areas.

✓Poverty Eradication through SHGs

Microcredit provided to 610 women SHGs (5,764 members) and 288 men's joint liability groups (1,211 members) to foster income-generating activities.




🍀 Celebrating Shri Girija Nandan "Girija Satish" 🍀

Bodhagaya (Gaya), January 8, 2025: A joint meeting of Lok Samiti and Mazdoor Kisan Samiti was held at Jeevan Sangam, Domohan, chaired by National Coordinator Mr. Kaushal Ganesh Azad.

Key issues discussed:

✓ Unresolved 19-point memorandum submitted to the Gaya District Collector, highlighting demands like:

- Reinstating the Agricultural Produce Market Committee.
- Enacting a Minimum Support Price law.
- Raising Kisan Samman Yojana benefits to ₹5,000.
- Land rights for villagers & settlement certificates.
- Restoring irrigation facilities and building crucial infrastructure.

XThe government has ignored these demands, leaving problems unresolved.

The meeting also condemned the brutal murder of journalist Mukesh Chandrakar and demanded ₹50 lakh compensation for his family.

Next meeting will be held on February 9, 2025, to plan peaceful protests.
