SBI Gram Saksham: Water Conservation Empowering Farmers!

Jamui-Deoghar, 22 March 2025: On World Water Day, farmers in Jamui & Deoghar celebrated the impact of the SBI Gram Saksham Project, implemented by NBJK with support from SBI Foundation. This initiative has renovated 200+ wells, deepened 39 ponds, and provided 600 farmers with electric motor pumps, ensuring year-round irrigation and improved agricultural productivity!
