🌸 Netra Vasant – Inclusive Eye & Social Security Camp 🌸

Hazaribagh (Jharkhand), 20 August 2025: With the support of Sightsavers India, Nav Bharat Jagriti Kendra (NBJK) organized an Inclusive Eye Screening & Social Security Camp at Ramdev Khairka Panchayat Bhawan, Daru block in Hazaribagh district.

👁️ A total of 68 people, including 33 persons with disabilities, received eye check-ups. 16 cataract cases were identified, out of which 11 patients were referred to Lok Nayak Jai Prakash Eye Hospital, Bahera (Chouparan) for free surgeries with the help of the Mobile Eye Care Unit.

👉 The camp was supported by JSLPS, Department of Social Security, and local Panchayat members.

💠 Services included renewal of disability certificates, UDID registration, Ayushman Health Card, pension schemes, ration cards, railway concession passes, and assistive devices like crutches, hearing aids, tricycles, and battery-operated cycles.

📖 An awareness session was also held on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.

From Disability to Dignity: Young Man with Locomotor Disability Becomes Self-Reliant Welder



Patna (Bihar), 10 August 2025: Binod Kumar, a young man from Gayghat in Patna City, has transformed his life from dependency to dignity with the support of Nav Bharat Jagriti Kendra (NBJK) and Bajaj Finserv under their *Community-Based Inclusive Development & Rehabilitation (CBID) of Persons with Disabilities* program. Belonging to an underprivileged family,

Binod's father works as a seasonal laborer while his siblings engage in daily wage jobs. Financial struggles often left the family struggling for basic needs. Living with a locomotor disability, Binod faced additional challenges in mobility and livelihood.

His association with the Disabled People's Organization (DPO), promoted under the CBID program, opened new opportunities. With the program's help, he obtained a UDID card and Disability Certificate, enabling access to government entitlements. Showing interest in welding, he was enrolled in a local workshop for hands-on training. To support his mobility, the program provided him a tricycle.

Upon completing his training, Binod received financial assistance under the program's Income Generation Activity to start his own roadside welding shop. The local Ward Member further supported him by arranging space for the workshop.

Today, Binod earns more than Rs. 500 a day, runs his welding unit independently, and contributes to his family's income.
