18 November 2025, Khunti: Under the TRIBES project implemented by NBJK and supported by NABARD, CGM Mrs. Deepmala Ghosh visited Jivari village in Khunti district to review field activities. She interacted with farmers and appreciated their



adoption of Semialata-based lac cultivation, promoted under the project with 1,200 Semialata plants and 20 Kusum trees on 50 decimals of land.

Farmers such as Soto Manki, Muchirai Manki, Sutugan Purti and Turlen Dhan shared how this initiative has increased their income and brought positive changes to their families. Experts noted that Semialata improves soil health through nitrogen fixation and grows without chemical fertilizers.

Mrs. Ghosh also encouraged rural artisans by purchasing lac bangles displayed at the local exhibition.
