Seminar on International Women's Day

09 March 2026, Patna: On the occasion of International Women's Day, a seminar on De-addiction, Eradication of Superstition, and Women's Empowerment was organised at Gandhi Nidhi Sabhagar, Congress Maidan, Kadamkuan, Patna, under the aegis of Bihar Pradesh Lok Samiti, with support from Jagriti Socio-Economic Empowerment Services, Ranchi.
