Empowering Teachers to Protect Children's Rights



Hazaribagh, 29 June 2026: UNICEF, in collaboration with Nav Bharat Jagriti Kendra (NBJK), organized a one-day Child Rights Workshop for 60 teachers and headmasters from 60 government schools across six blocks of Hazaribagh district. The workshop strengthened teachers' understanding of child

rights, child protection, child marriage, child labour, violence against children, and creating safe, inclusive, and child-friendly schools. Officials from the Education Department also participated, reaffirming their commitment to safeguarding every child's rights.

By equipping teachers with the right knowledge and skills, the initiative aims to foster safer learning environments where every child can learn, grow, and thrive.

Bringing quality eye care closer to underserved communities!

Deoghar, 27 June 2026: During June 2026 (till 26th), Nav Bharat Jagriti Kendra's Vimla Ramkrishna Bajaj Eye Hospital (VRBEH), Deoghar conducted 9 outreach eye screening camps in the remote villages of Chakai and Sono blocks of Jamui district and Deoghar Sadar block of Deoghar district with support from Seva Foundation.

Key achievements:

- 👁️ 208 patients screened
- 🕶️ 76 cases of refractive errors identified
- 🔍 85 cataract cases detected
- 🩸 12 cases of pterygium identified
- 💊 29 patients provided free medicines
- 🏠 6 patients referred for advanced treatment

All identified cataract patients will receive free cataract surgery along with transportation, accommodation, meals, medicines and post-operative follow-up support. The outreach eye screening camps and cataract surgeries are being supported by Seva Foundation.

Additionally, VRBEH's Vision Center at Jamua, Giridih served 163 patients, identifying 123 cases of refractive errors and 31 cataract cases. Underprivileged cataract patients will also receive free surgery at the base hospital.



Emergency, 25 June 1975: A Blot on Democracy



Hazaribagh, 25 June 2026: A thought-provoking discussion was organized today at Hazaribagh Press Club by District Lok Samiti and Jagriti to mark the 51st anniversary of the Emergency imposed in India on 25 June 1975. Speakers, including former JP Movement activists, advocates, academicians, and social workers, reflected on the importance of

democratic values, freedom of expression, civil liberties, and the role of citizens in safeguarding democracy. They emphasized that the Emergency remains a reminder of the dangers of suppressing dissent and constitutional rights.

🚐 Bringing Healthcare Closer to Rural Communities



Chatra/Godda/Pakur, 15 June 2026: Under the SBI Sanjeevani – Clinic on Wheels Program, supported by SBI Foundation, quality healthcare services are reaching underserved villages in Chatra, Godda, and Pakur districts through Mobile Medical Units (MMUs). In the last month -

- ✔️ 136 health camps organized
- ✔️ 3,033 patients provided medical consultation and treatment
- ✔️ Free medicines distributed
- ✔️ On-the-spot pathological testing facilities available
- ✔️ Health awareness camps conducted in all three

districts

The programme currently covers 60 villages across Kunda & Lawalong blocks of Chatra, Poraiyahat block of Godda, and Pakuriya block of Pakur district.

District-wise achievements:

- 📍 Chatra – 932 patients treated and 412 pathological tests conducted
- 📍 Godda – 1,154 patients treated and 456 pathological tests conducted
- 📍 Pakur – 947 patients treated and 182 pathological tests conducted

The Mobile Medical Units are equipped with essential diagnostic and treatment facilities and staffed by a Medical Officer, ANM, Pharmacist, Lab Technician, and Driver, ensuring healthcare services reach people at their doorstep.

Together, we are advancing accessible and affordable healthcare for rural communities.

🌱 World Environment Day Celebrated with a Focus on Organic Farming and Tree Plantation 🌳
